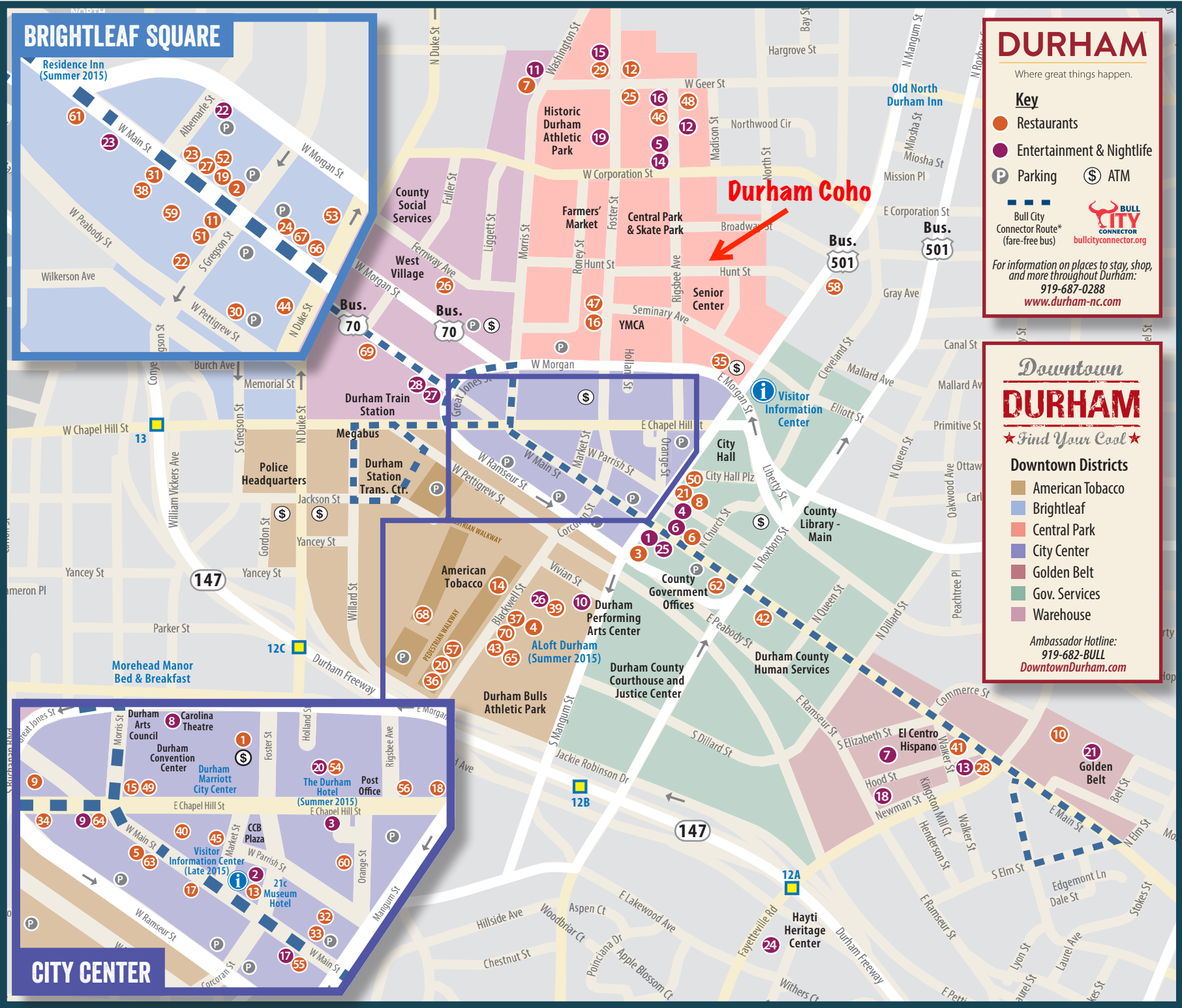


# DOWNTOWN DURHAM DINING & ENTERTAINMENT MAP
